





Tarremah Master Plan

The development of the Tarremah School has been in stages as the pupil population increases and resources become available. The master plan directs the orderly growth of the school from kindergarten to grade 12 balancing educational needs with financial constraints to ensure the continued viability of the school.

The process has included numerous workshops and consultation with the school community; successive funding applications; and spatial, financial & educational studies.

The buildings form a series of linked courtyards that provide:

- climatic protection from an open and exposed site
- intimate spaces of appropriate scale
- a range of spaces for varied school activities
- a shaded amphitheatre forming an outdoor school hub at the heart of the primary school

Environmentally responsible practices have been followed throughout to provide low environmental impact and healthy buildings.

Buildings are orientated to maximise solar gain and natural day lighting.

Natural materials of low embodied energy and low toxicity are used wherever possible.
